**"Education is the most powerful weapon you can use to change the world."**-Nelson Mandela. Education is vital to sustainable development. Citizens of the world need to learn their way to sustainability. Our current knowledge base does not contain the solutions to present-day global environmental, societal and economic problems. Today's education is crucial to the ability of present and future leaders and citizens to create solutions and find new paths to a better future.

Education for sustainable development (ESD) is not a particular programme or project, but is rather an umbrella for many forms of education that already exist, and new ones that remain to be created. ESD promotes efforts to rethink educational programmes and systems (both methods and contents) that currently support unsustainable societies. ESD affects all components of education: legislation, policy, finance, curriculum, instruction, learning, assessment, etc. ESD calls for lifelong learning and recognizes the fact that the educational needs of people change over their lifetime. Many individuals and organizations around the world already implement ESD (e.g. a teacher weaving sustainability themes into primary education using participatory methods; a community development worker raising people's awareness on rights which are denied to them; or a public health worker training people to draw water from clean sources). ESD can be implemented in myriad ways, so that ESD programmes reflect the unique environmental, social, cultural and economic conditions of each locality. Furthermore, ESD increases civil capacity by enhancing and improving society, through a combination of formal, non-formal and informal education.

In 2005, the UN Decade of Education for Sustainable Development was launched to enhance the role of education in promoting sustainable development. It has generated many success stories to be scaled up, with many intergovernmental agreements on sustainable development now duly recognizing the importance of education. At the UN Conference on Sustainable Development in 2012 (Rio+20), the international community agreed to "promote education for sustainable development, and to integrate sustainable development more actively into education beyond the UN Decade of Education for Sustainable Development". In 2013, the 37th session of the General Conference of UNESCO endorsed the Global Action Programme (GAP) on ESD as the follow-up to the Decade. The GAP was launched at the UNESCO World Conference on Education for Sustainable Development held on 10-12 November 2014 in Aichi-Nagoya, Japan.

With this aim in view we have highly developed through academic, research and extension activities brightness and the college has achieved newer elevation in education and research and tries to solve environmental, societal and economic problems, which has yielded positive results and **Lakhimpur Girls' College has been reaccredited with 'A' grade by NAAC on 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2014.**

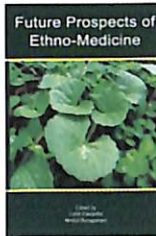
