

IQAC: LAKHIMPUR GIRLS' COLLEGE

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Lakhimpur Girls' College was formed in February, 2005, just after Accreditation of NAAC to activate the process of developing the capabilities of the College and to raise the standards of the College to higher levels so that the College makes continuous improvement in quality. The IQAC identified various processes identified by NAAC that augment the quality of the College. Among them, quality enhancement, seeking feedback and obtaining qualitative and quantitative information for reforming the system are worth mentioning. On the basis of these processes, the IQAC has submitted three Annual Reports to NAAC. And presently it is preparing a Self-Study Report to submit to NAAC for Re-accreditation

and acquire the IEQA status.

As parts of this endeavour, the IQAC is monitoring the Best Practices Promotion and Quality Promotion in the College. Construction works have been taken up for infrastructural development and providing sufficient sanitary facilities to the students. It is also taking measures to achieve 75% student attendance and organizing regular exams and internal assessments and promoting extra-curricular and extension activities among the students.


