Programme Name: NSS Special Village Camping Programme

Date: 11/11/2021

Venue: Gharmora Gosai Chapori Gaon, North Lakhimpur

Number of participants: 100

A seven days special camp was held from 11th November 2021 to 17th November 2021 at Gharmora Gosai Chapori Gaon, Lakhimpur. 100 nos. of NSS volunteers and 11 (Eleven) nos. of faculties of Lakhimpur Girls' College participated in the camp. Dr. Surajit Bhuyan, Principal Lakhimpur Girls' College has inaugurated the camp and delivered a speech. Vice Principal of Lakhimpur Girls' College Mr. K. S. Khandetroy and Mr. Bhadereswar Das, Gram Sevak of Gharmora Gosai Chapori Gaon, Lakhimpur have participated the camp.

Following activities were undertaken during the camp-

1. **Cleaniness drive** done at Lakhimpur High School, Gharmora Gosai chapori L.P.School, Gharmora Namghar, Gharmora Satra and Village Roads of Gharmora Gosai Chapori Gaon.
2. **Plantation drive:** 40 nos. of saplings planted at Gharmora Gosai Chapori L.P.School, Gharmora Namghar, Gharmora Satra and Lakhimpur High School by NSS volunteers of . Lakhimpur Girls' College.
3. Health awareness programme: A health awareness programme on **Menstrual Hygiene and Related Health Issues of Women** was organized at Gharmora Gosai Chapori, North Lakhimpur, where Dr Roopa Roy Dutta, Associate Professor, Department of Home Science, Mrs. Binita Hazarika, Associate Professor and HOD, Department of Physics and Mrs. Malabika Chaliha, Associate Professor , Department of Botany, Lakhimpur Girls' College participated as resource persons. Total 90 Nos. of village female including adolescent girls have participated from the village. Free **sanitary pads** have been distributed among the girls. Three NSS volunteers Ms. Pardita Bonia, Ms. Kasmita Dutta and Roma Gohain also delivered talk on Menstrual Hygiene and Related Health Issues of Women.

4. Free Health Check Up Camp- A free **Hemoglobin Testing and Blood Group Testing** camp was organized in Gharmora Gosai Sapori Gaon (Adopted Village) by NSS Unit of Lakhimpur Girls' College. A medical
5. team from Gharmora PHC has been arranged for the camp. Mrs. Malabika Chaliha, Associate Professor, Department of Botany, Lakhimpur Girls' College delivered a lecture to make aware the village people about deficiency of hemoglobin and food habits. The programme was attended by total 107 participants. The blood screening camp run in between the programme, screened the blood of 37 people, identified blood group and measured the hemoglobin level.
6. An awareness programme on **Covid-19 Distribution** was organized in Gharmora Gosai Sapori Gaon (Adopted Village) by NSS Unit of Lakhimpur Girls' College. NSS volunteers have delivered talk on **Covid-19. Free Mask and Sanitizers** have been distributed among the village people and the school students.
7. Organized one lecture at Lakhimpur High School. Ms. Nibedita Sarma, Assistant Professor, Department of Education delivered a talk to the students of the school. 50 students of the school participated in the programme.
8. An awareness programme on plastic and waste management was organized in Gharmora Gosai Sapori Gaon (Adopted Village) by NSS Unit of Lakhimpur Girls' College. 50 NSS volunteers have participated in the programme. A leaflet containing no use of plastic slogans, its alternatives and waste management has been prepared by the NSS volunteers and distributed among the village people to make aware about the no use of plastics.
