A UGC funded National Seminar on ***Challenges to Human Rights in Northeast India*** was successfully organized by the department of Political Science and the department of Education, Lakhimpur Girls' College. Scholars and academicians from different parts of the state participated in the seminar and interactive sessions were held on different aspects of Human Rights situation in Northeast India. Prof. P.K. Panigrahi (Rajiv Gandhi University), Prof. Akhil Ranjan Dutta (Guwahati University), and Mr. Horen Kumar Bora (Former Vice-Principal of the College) joined the event as resource persons.
