The STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY (SSS) was conducted among the students of Lakhimpur Girls' College for the session 2020-2021. The survey was conducted with the help of a questionnaire based on NAAC guidelines covering five areas viz. 'Teaching Learning Process', 'Effectiveness of Communication', 'Teaching Learning Resources', 'Counseling Experience', 'Assessment and Evaluation'. The questionnaire was framed to measure the students' levels of satisfaction on the teaching learning experience provided by Lakhimpur Girls' College. A total of 307 students were selected to collect data of student satisfaction survey for the session 2020-2021.

The students' satisfaction with the teaching learning provided by Lakhimpur Girls' College was measured with the help of a set of questions covering five major areas. The responses were analyzed bellow in a table form:
