

A Report on the Webinar “Game Theory: Can there be a theory to play a game?”

A webinar on “Game Theory: Can there be a theory to play a game?” was organized by the Department of Mathematics, Lakhimpur Girls’ College in collaboration with GonitSora (<https://gonitsora.com/>) and IQAC, Lakhimpur Girls’ College on 12th June 2020. The program was coordinated by Dr. Parama Dutta, Assistant Professor of Department of Mathematics, Lakhimpur Girls’ College. Prof. Surajit Borkotokey from the Department of Mathematics, Dibrugarh University was invited as a resource person to deliver a popular talk on Mathematics. In this talk, Prof. Borkotokey gave an introduction of Game Theory. He discussed how a social situation can be considered as a game and how a theory can be developed from that game. He also gave mathematical explanation of certain game or incidents like Akbar-Birbal Bathub with full of milk, the survivor Thailand, the prisoner’s dilemma etc. A total of 376 people registered for the program from all over India and around 230 people attended the live program. The program was also live streamed in the official Facebook page of GonitSora where we have got more than 3000 views.
