Paper(s) should be typed in 12-point Times New Roman font using 1.15 Line spacing. Headings should be in Bold Capital Letters and Sub-Headings in Italic Running Letters.

A. Research Papers having Empirical Studies should contain,

1. Title (should be short, fewer than 60 characters with spaces)
2. Title of Author (s) (names of authors, the affiliations, addresses, e-mail addresses, phone numbers of author and co-authors)
3. Abstract (should be between 150-300 words)
4. Keywords (please provide 4-6 keywords)
5. Introduction
6. Rationale or justification of the Paper
7. Definitions of terms used
8. Review of related literature/historical background/supporting theories
9. Aims and Objectives
10. Research questions or Hypotheses, if any.
11. Methodology, research design and data Collection
12. Data Analysis and result or finding
13. Interpretation, discussion, contributions and recommendations
14. Conclusion
15. Acknowledgements, if any.
16. References (in APA format)
17. Tables (must be editable), Figures, etc.

B. For Papers like Policy Review, Argumentative or Persuasive, Review Article, discussion, Informative type, - authors may also adopt the above format wherever applicable, for systematic presentation.
