Girls' High School inaugurated the college on 16th August 1972, and was named as North Lakhimpur Girls' College but on 17th May 1975 it was rechristened as Lakhimpur Girls' College to represent higher education for women of the entire district.

Presently, Lakhimpur Girls' College offer education to Higher Secondary and Degree students of both Arts and Science Stream. The college also offer Master degree in Home Science. It also offer distance course under KKHSOU and UGC certificate courses. The college has a well-digitalised Central library, Language lab, digital classroom and Computer lab. The College is also planning to introduce 4 years integrated B.Ed. course shortly.
